## General Comments on Examination Paper

An average set of responses from a large sample size. Centres and candidates are reminded once again **not** to write in the margins – this is for the markers use only. Candidates should start each new answer on a new side of each page. The question and sub parts being attempted should be CLEARLY marked.

## General Comments of Specific Examination Questions

- Q1. Generally, well answered although several candidates did not provide adequate influencing factors for part (b) or did not understand the question.
- Q2. Some lacked a description in part (b) losing marks.
- Q3. Many candidates did not consider the fact that belts tend to wear and chains elongate. Others failed to mention the effect on valve timing and the subsequent problems.
- Q4. No comments.
- Q5. Poorly answered by some candidates and some did not provide any typical uses as asked.
- Q6. Poorly answered by some who failed to describe the **problems** encountered and merely concentrated on the causes.
- Q7. Several candidates failed to provide any **description** with poor sketches.
- Q8. A relatively easy 10 marks were not achieved by those who chose to provide a **list** of 5 or 6 reasons. There are well over 10 with a little engineering imagination. Again, some with no description.
- Q9. No comments.
- Q10. Several candidates lost marks by failing to state causes and chose to state the effects.
